

THE GRIFFITH DEVELOPMENTAL SCALE

MONTHS OF AGE	LOCOMOTOR
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lifts chin when prone. Pushes with feet against examiner's hands. Holds head erect for a few seconds.
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lifts head up when prone. Kicks vigorously.
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Active in bath – kicks. Lifts head when in dorsal position. Rolls from side to back.
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Back firm when held in sitting position. Lifts head and chest when prone. Holds head erect continuously.
5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lifts head and shoulders, dorsal. Rolls from side to side.
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plays with own toes. Crawling Reactions (I): Draws up knees, etc. Sits with slight support.
7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can roll from back to stomach, etc. Stepping Reaction (a): Dancing movements.
8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Crawling (II): Tries vigorously to crawl. Sits alone for a short time. Stepping Reaction (b): One foot in front of the other.
9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Crawling (III): Can turn around when left on floor. Can be left sitting on floor. Crawling (IV): Makes some progress forwards or backwards.
10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stands when held up. Sits well in chair
11	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pulls self up by furniture. Can stand holding to furniture.
12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Crawling (V): Creeps on hands and knees, etc. Side-steps round inside cot or play-pen holding rails. Can walk when led.
13	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Climbs on a low ledge or step. Stands alone.
14	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Walks alone. Kneels on floor or chair.
15	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Climbs stairs up. Likes pushing pram, toy horse, and so forth.
16	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Trots about well.
17	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stoops. Climbs on a low chair.
18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can walk backwards.
19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Walks pulling toy or string. Climbs stairs up and down.
20	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Jumps. Runs.
21	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Walks upstairs.
22	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Climbs to stand on a chair. Can jump off a step.
23	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can seat himself at table. Walks up and down stairs.
24	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can kick ball. Can be trusted on stairs alone.
