



Virtual Visit Preparation Checklist

1 TECH SETUP

- Staff have equipment and tech support needed
- Assess whether families have the tech set up for virtual visits
- Some families may need some tech support
- Privacy and security (HIPPA compliance, if applicable)



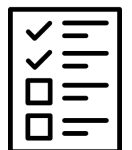
2 DISCUSSING VIRTUAL VISITS

- Ask family whether they want to participate in virtual visits now (check back later if now is not good)
- Continue check-ins with families who don't or can't participate in virtual visits now (texts, letters, emails, calls etc)



3 PRACTICE PROTOCOLS

- Follow guidelines provided by state and local authorities to deal with COVID-19
- Gather up-to-date local resources in order to connect families
- Support family and extend beyond the usual home visit
- Create your site's own protocols and standards based on the needs of families and staff
- Family-led, flexible, and creative
- Establish boundaries

- Take care of yourself
- Provide staff extra support and supervision
- Join the network, share your experiences, and learn from each other
